#### Mendlesham Airfield Exhibition at the Middy Railway Museum

We're thrilled to report the success of our recent exhibition at Middy Railway Museum over Easter Weekend about the Mendlesham Airfield during WWII. Over the two days, we had an incredible turnout, with more than 110 visitors signing our visitors' book. And with some entries representing whole families and not every visitor signing in, our total attendance likely surpassed 150 individuals – a testament to the community's interest.

The feedback from our visitors has been overwhelmingly positive, with many expressing their gratitude for the opportunity to delve into the history of Mendlesham Airfield and the courageous airmen who served during World War II.

Among the treasures shared with us during the exhibition were a remarkable embroidered "tea towel" from 1944 adorned with airmen's signatures, along with a curious thermometer gauge, both offering tangible connections to the past. Additionally, we were privileged to hear the incredible story of Phil and Anne Webb's encounter with a 99-year-old "Mendlesham" veteran pilot in America, who shared his experiences of flying 35 missions during the war.

We're also grateful for the enthusiastic support of the railway staff who took the time to visit the exhibition, adding to the warm and welcoming atmosphere.

In summary, we were really pleased with the success of the Exhibition, enabling us to both celebrate and commemorate a significant chapter in our Community's history. Thank you to everyone who attended, contributed, and supported our endeayour.

The next opportunity to visit the Exhibition will be on 12 May 2024. Stay tuned for updates on our ongoing mission to secure a more permanent home for our cherished memorabilia and artefacts. Together, let's continue to preserve and honour our heritage for generations to come.







I recently started a new job where my boss has told me I'll have to work on bank holidays. This was never the case in my old job. Can my employer really make me work on a public holiday, and should I get paid extra if I do?

Unfortunately, when it comes to bank holidays, whether staff have to work is up to their employer, and you don't have to be paid more if you do. The situation will vary from job to job and may depend on several factors such as whether your place of work is open on bank holidays, your hours of work and crucially, what your contract says.

Look at your contract, if you have one, to find out what your personal situation is. Your contract might say you will always get bank holidays off, but it might say you may sometimes be required to work them or will always be required to work. But if your contract says you get bank holidays off you shouldn't be asked to work.

Your contract might say something like: "In addition to bank and public holidays, your annual entitlement to holidays is X days". This means you get public holidays off in addition to your annual leave entitlement, but it might not mean you're entitled to take the specific days off. You may be required to work a bank holiday, in which case you should get another day off instead.

Alternatively, it might say something like: "Your annual holiday entitlement (inclusive of bank and public holidays) is X days" - this means you have to take bank holidays off as part of your annual leave entitlement. Bank holidays will either be deducted from your annual leave allowance (so you'll have to book all bank holidays as paid time off) or counted as additional holiday days.

A common misunderstanding around bank holidays is that employers have to pay you extra for working them. This is not the case. Unless your contract says you'll be paid extra you will just be paid your normal amount. If your contract says you are entitled to bank holidays but you're asked to work, you should be able to take a different day off in lieu. Your employer must follow what's set out in your contract. If they don't, you should raise this with them.

If you don't have a contract, the legal default position is that your employer can tell you when you can or can't take time off. If you'd like to request a bank holiday off, use the normal method for requesting time off.

If you find you need to resolve an issue with your employer, first ask for an informal chat, where you can raise your concerns. If this doesn't get you anywhere, you may need to raise a formal grievance. If you need advice on this, contact Citizens Advice Mid Suffolk.



"Yes, even on my servants, both men and women, I will pour out my Spirit in those days, and they will proclaim my message."

In the Christian calendar we go from the hope at Easter to starting to preach the message of the Good News in May. We first have Ascension Day on the 9th May and Pentecost on the 19th May so it can be said that May is about an ending, and a new beginning.

Ascension Day is when we remember Christ ascending to be with his Father in Heaven, the last time he was to appear to his disciples here on earth. Pentecost is the Birthday of the Church, when the spirit was poured out on the Disciples, which marked the beginning of the Church.

As a Church, we could be said to be having endings and beginnings all the while. The Church over the centuries has gone through many changes both in worship, and the buildings in which we worship, this can be partly seen in the many denominations that we have. The Church of the past years has had to find new ways of being Church.

For the Church to be vibrant and relevant it has to be prepared to change, but not to go along with secular fads, the Church needs to be relevant to every generation, and sometimes for us that has been within the Church, for many vears those changes may not always seem necessary.

The challenge that each Pentecost gives us, is first to look back to that first Pentecost, to when the first Disciples were thought to be drunk, but were indeed infected by the Holy Spirit, to learn from them and to move forward in the power of the Holy Spirit. In our secular society Church is not as relevant as it once was, and our challenge is to show the world that the Church can still be relevant to them, and to us.

In his speech to the fledgling Church, at that first Pentecost Peter spoke the words of the prophet Joel:

"This is what I will do in the last days, God says "I will pour out my spirit on everyone. Your Sons and Daughters will proclaim my message, your young men will see visions, and your old men will have dreams yes even on my servants both men and women, I will pour out my spirit in these days, and they will proclaim my message."

Even today these words still have relevance for us, even in our days where science seems to have all the answers, if we only let the Holy Spirit in, it will be amazing to see how much the Church will become relevant, especially to a society that thinks it has all the answers.

This Pentecost let us treat it as though it is our first and ask God to send his Holy Spirit upon us and see where it leads us.

#### Fr Philip Writes ......

#### Eastertide concludes on 19th May.

The Christian faith is founded on one fact:

Jesus rose from the dead and he is our life. The lives of the early disciples were transformed by Jesus, and our lives can also be transformed if we are open to him. I give two true stories:

The first is an example from Walsingham: In the Guild of All Souls Chapel there are glass panels in black & grey, depicting death, gloom, pain and despair. Towards the altar the colours become brighter, finishing in yellow and white: these depict the Resurrection bringing hope from suffering. A man visited the chapel. His wife had left him and taken their 3 children to live with another man. One day that other man was repairing a car engine in the kitchen and it caught fire. The three children were killed. This pilgrim had lost his wife to someone else and his 3 children had been killed - effectively by that other

man. As can happen, the pilgrim had since come in contact with a loving, caring church and went to Walsingham to have his children remembered for ever on the day of their deaths. He also came to pray there before being Confirmed. Out of his tragedy, bitterness and suffering, his life was transformed by Jesus' resurrected life, which he experienced now.

Another example is a man I will call David, who tried to end his own life, but when he was aware he was outside his body in what seemed like a tunnel of light, met his father who had died 2 years before. I quote his words: "Since that time my life has been very different. God is a reality.... Christianity is, in fact, much fuller than I had come to realise." The Good news of Eastertide and Pentecost is that Jesus wants to work miracles in us. Please ask yourself: What miracle does God want to work in me?


